

## **General Business**

1. Vote of 'Thanks' to National Committee (J. Green)

J. Green proposed a vote of thanks to all outgoing and incoming committee on behalf of members. Acknowledged hard work and dedication of volunteers.

#### 2. Feedback on Bowen / Nth QLD LT Regatta (A. Haynes)

A. Haynes provided a quick summary of the excellent work being done at Port Denison Sailing Club and the hospitality of the recent regatta. Commended the Club and volunteers.

#### 3. Update on 2022 Worlds (S. Newman)

N.Bez provided update on entries (34 Aus as at 29/6) and charter process. Fantastic response from Aussies and already 165+ total entries. Reminder comm from Class to register for charters before July 7.

#### 4. Confirmation of RRS (G. Kitchen)

N.Bez provided confirmation that Class recommendation to use to standard RRS (not Windsurfing appendix) to include Mark Room with Zone. Confirmed this was used successfully at 2022 Nationals.
